There are various ways to get to the tourist attractions of Awajishima Island from places like Osaka or Kobe in only a short time. As well as a high-speed ferry, plenty of options like express buses run from Osaka and Kobe, meaning you can be on the island in around an hour. To get around the island itself, in addition to rental cars and taxis, you can use the network of route buses. Also, at any of the three tourist offices on the island you can hire bicycles. Trips focused on any of the many onsen hot spring hotels scattered around the island are also highly recommended.
